2026 FUNDING NEEDS

The Partners in Flight (PIF) website serves as the information hub for PIF. The website provides essential information for new and existing collaborators; offers a comprehensive resource library; and maintains active, topic-driven news feeds. The PIF website serves as an interactive platform for each of PIF's working groups and committees.

Need

Funds are required: to offer secure web services, committee mailing lists, social media accounts, and digital meeting platforms; for domain and website hosting; to maintain active communications, including up-to-date web content, news feeds, and social media; to manage the PIF resource library, which includes conservation plans, the PIF technical series, reports and publications, and other conservation science and educational resources; and to coordinate virtual meeting logistics. Additionally, the PIF website requires a full redesign to keep up with modern web security and infrastructure.

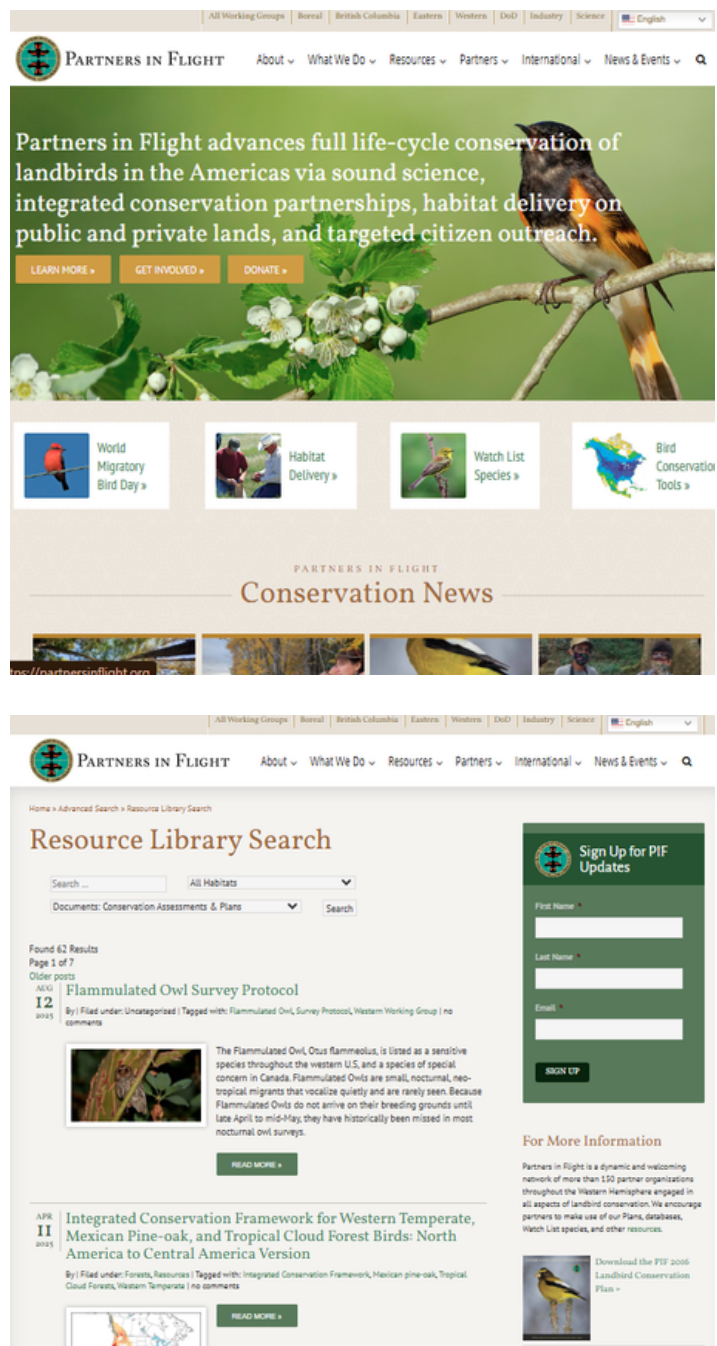

Cycle of Funding

The 2026 budget (see table above) covers ongoing costs, plus a full website redesign. The website redesign is a one-time cost; it is not annual.

Outcomes and Benefits

As PIF's primary platform for sharing information and engaging with partners, the site should be easy to navigate, well-organized, and reliable. Upgrading its management tools, navigation, and security will strengthen the user experience and make PIF tools and resources more accessible and user-friendly for land managers, including state biologists. These improvements will also support a centralized hub for future PIF resources, tools, and products.
